
ERVCDA & Plymouth Fire Department & Ladies Auxiliary Christmas Holiday Market

The Grand Master's project of the IOOF Grand Lodge of the Atlantic Provinces was to raise money in support of the elementary schools' breakfast program. This is the fifth

year fourteen schools in the area, from
Tatamagouche to Frank H in Sutherland's River,
have received funding. Six people, of which one is
Lester Ward, sold tickets to raise money for this
project. At first each school was given
\$100. Enough money was raised this year to give
each school \$200. In order for this to happen \$5600
was raised.

Lester is the town crier for Hopewell and buys candy himself to hand out during the tree lighting. He finds different shaped tree limbs and makes them into walking sticks. In exchange for a stick people give him money to go towards the breakfast program.

In recognition of their efforts, Lester and the others received the King Charles III

coronation pin from the office of the Hon. Sean Fraser. Pictou County School children are so fortunate to have a friend in the person of Lester Ward. The East River Valley communities are proud to have Lester in their midst.
